

# Travelling With Your Pet To EU Post Brexit



## October 31 2019 (dogs, cats, ferrets)

If Uk leaves with NO Deal :

- Must have microchip
- Must Have Rabies Vaccination
- Must have Rabies blood test at least 30 days after vaccination
- If passes blood test, you must wait 3 months before you can travel with your pet.
- Passport will not be valid. Therefore you must visit an official veterinarian (Ani-Medics can do this) and they will issue a single use Animal Health Certificate which will be valid for travel to the EU for up to 10 days post issue.
